
Before I share more details, - I would like to communicate a few stories...

Our students all have a level of complexity within their personal story. The students learning about who they are and why they do the things they do with the Myers/Briggs Personality Profile is foundational to their one-on-one coaching and seminars. The Myers/Briggs assessment has created a tremendous dialogue, which has encouraged their personal growth and development and increased their decision-making skills.

ne student's story stands out, as she is a strong introvert. She came to understand how she best gains energy - typically, by being alone or in a small group of friends. Her new knowledge about herself has helped her to feel more comfortable about being in situations where she needs to participate in a larger group or leadership position. She is now able to manage her time more effectively by scheduling time to reflect and rejuvenate when she has needed to expend more energy by being with others. Also, she has become more comfortable with her own story as she applies to colleges, scholarships and awarded recognition opportunities.

He had to rely on his older siblings to do the parenting in their absence. Our student faced uncertainty, anger and even fear with his situation

His friends have been and are a tremendous support to him. They encouraged him to be a part of Future Farmers of America. They invited him to be a part of the FYW pilot program this past year fully supported and funded by the partnership of

And mentored through our one-on-one coaching and group seminars, which has supported him to think more broadly about his life and future career. He has learned how to process information and build his communication skills. He better understands how he makes decisions and what decisions are best for him and his future dreams. He has learned how to manage the way he likes to plan, organize and get things done. Ultimately, he has learned to be a good TEAM member, as well. He is learning to lead himself...FIRST and well.

And, there are students who anticipate their acceptance to the University at Davis and Stanford University.
